TENNIS and PAVILION RULES AND REGULATIONS

HOW TO MAKE A RESERVATION:

- Reservations are made through the www.siennahoa.org website.
- Please read all Rules and Regulations below.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

- Tennis Courts: 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM daily.

PRIME TIME HOURS:

- Prime time (adults only 18 years and older) will be from 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM every day. A child may play with an adult during prime time, however, during ALTA season, matches that are delayed due to rain take precedent.
- If no adult is present, children may use the court during prime time hours, however, children must surrender the court if a group of adults wish to play.

RESERVATIONS RULES:

Rules for Reserving the Pavilion

- The pavilion may be booked 30 days in advance for private parties. The social committee may book the pavilion more than 30 days in advance for community wide functions.

Rules for Reserving the Tennis Courts

- For social play, courts may be reserved no more than (7) days in advance by adults (18 years and older).
- For singles and doubles leagues such as K Swiss, League Tennis, or T2 matches, the courts may be booked (14) days in advance.
- Any reservation greater than 7 days in advance must be approved and scheduled by the Tennis Committee. Either contact Lisa Eichler, Tennis Committee Chair, by emailing lisaseichler@gmail.com, or by using the proper [eForm](#) within the website.
- For Team Lessons, Practice, and Matches such as ALTA and USTA
 - The tennis courts may be booked prior to the season, for the duration of the season
 - A team may only book both courts for 1 night a week in advance for the entire season
 - Any additional team practices or lessons must be booked on a week to week basis
 - ALL Sienna Tennis teams who wish to book the courts early for the season must submit a full roster to the Tennis Committee for prior approval
 - Once approved the Tennis Committee will work with you to understand and reserve the dates on your behalf

- A group of private lessons may also be booked in advance by submitting a list of players to the tennis committee for prior approval. Click [here](#) to contact Tennis Committee.

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GENERAL RULES AND REDULATIONS

- Only flat sole tennis shoes may be worn on the court. No black sole shoes are allowed. No waffle sole shoes. (Please honor this requirement and pay attention to the soles on your shoes!)
- All players must exhibit proper sportsmanship while using the tennis courts, i.e., no throwing of Rackets, no profanity, and no inappropriate behavior.
- Children under twelve (12) years old must be supervised by an adult while playing tennis.
- Children who are not playing tennis shall not be allowed on the court.
- Metal rackets should have guards for protection of court surfaces.
- No one other than the actual players may be inside the fenced area. Those waiting to play, spectators and children must stay outside the fenced area.
- No pets, chairs, stools, furniture, baby strollers, playpens or baby beds are allowed inside the fenced area.
- During matches please advise spectator guests to not use cell phones and to be mindful not to distract players. Spectators should make every effort to keep children from playing around the fence area of the courts during match play.
- **NO GLASS** containers will be allowed on the tennis courts. Any food items and wrappers must be cleaned up and removed from the court after play.
- Jumping and/or swinging on the nets and fences **is strictly prohibited**.
- For safety purposes, court gates must be kept closed at all times.
- **NO SMOKING** inside the fenced area.
- Courts are for tennis only. Bikes, skates (including in line/roller blades) or other activities are strictly prohibited. No basketball or other sports may be played inside the fenced area.
- If you are the last player to leave at night, please make sure the lights are turned off.
- Men must wear shirts while playing tennis.
- Any person causing damage to the tennis facilities, equipment or property, whether by negligence or misconduct, will be responsible to reimburse the Community Association for costs associated with repairing the damage. Parents shall be responsible for damage caused by their children.

GUEST PRIVILEGES:

- Guests are permitted when accompanied by an Association Member.
- We ask that each Association Member use reasonable discretion with Guest Privileges, and be considerate of other Association Members.

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RENTAL PROPERTIES:

If a homeowner is utilizing their Sienna property as a rental, it is highly recommended for the homeowner(s) to ensure to provide a copy of these Tennis Rules and Regulations to his/her/their tenant(s):

- It is each homeowner's responsibility to ensure his/her/their tenant(s) and their tenant's guest(s) comply with these Tennis Rules and Regulations.
- Homeowners will be liable and responsible for any damages caused by his/her/their tenant(s) and their tenant's guest(s).

SUSPENSION OF RIGHTS:

- Tennis use privileges may be suspended by the Board for non-payment of Assessments or charges and for any other violations of the Associations legal documents.
- Violation of the Tennis Rules and Regulations may result in the implication suspension of tennis privileges and/or the imposition of other legal sanctions by the Board in accordance with the Declaration, Bylaws, and Rules and Regulations.

Please be advised that the Sienna HOA Board of Directors may from time to time make necessary changes to these Tennis Rules and Regulations.

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
